


# HOW TO USE SCRAP FABRIC VOL. 3



drawstring pouch

**P.S. TIP!**  
Depending on what fabric you use, unfinished edges may pose more or less of a structural concern.



If you run into issues, try running a zigzag or whip stitch along the fraying edge.  
**ULTIMATELY REMEMBER YOU'RE MAKING TREASURE FROM TRASH!**

**STEP 1**  
Cut shapes

no more than 1/2 in thick!

8 in

**STRING**

(or at least 1/2 in) x2  
ribbon, yarn, or fortified fabric strip

**BAG**

! ON FOLD (or x2) !

**STEP 2**  
Sew side seams

right sides together

leave 1 in at the top

**SEWING VOCAB!**  
RIGHT side = pattern WPOING side = back

**STEP 3**  
Sew top channel

**STEP 4**  
flip inside out

if you didn't cut on a fold, also sew bottom seam

**STEP 5**  
Sew top binding

if you're using ribbon try finishing ends with a lighter

in one side... and back through the other!

repeat in the opposite direction

loop

USE a safety pin to help thread!
